## CONTINUED MEETING

Supervisor Jaeger welcomed Greg Mills and Bob Wilson, members of the Senior Services Committee.

County Wide will bring in topsoil and seed some areas.

Motion by Trustee Wissing/second by Trustee LaCure to approve the 2006 contract with Clarke Mosquito Abatement. Motion carried unanimously.
