

Someone You Should Know

Sixty-five years after his service in World War II, Merritt King has been honored by the French government with the French Legion of Honor, Chevalier (see picture left). A fascinating, multi-faceted man, Merritt has made a difference in his 90 years. He continues to live a full life; serving our country in World War II, serving Geneva in numerous civic roles and leading a colorful life with “no regrets.” Merritt’s close family roots gave him strong family values and the desire to be a “good citizen.” He attended the Art Institute



and the Lithography Institute in Chicago, which prepared him to become a cartographer in WWII. Merritt’s decorated service to our country has resulted in a Purple Heart and a Bronze star among other awards. Merritt met his late wife, Lynne, at a USO dance in London, England. They married in 1945 and were fortunate to enjoy 50 years of marriage, two daughters, Alison and Leslie, and lost a son Brian. In his leisure time, Merritt enjoys gardening, golfing and reading history. His civic involvement is impressive including being Geneva Mayor *Pro-Tem* for 14 years and an alderman for 28 years. Service is a huge part of his life. Recently, Merritt was part of an Honor Flight to Washington D.C. to see the WWII Memorial where he and other veterans were honored. Merritt is a man who loves life, loves Geneva, loves the Geneva Township Senior Center. Congratulations Merritt!


