RTA SENIOR RIDE PROGRAM CHANGES

In August, the RTA will send new permit cards to all seniors who currently have a "ride free" fare card. Individuals enrolled in the circuit breaker program will receive a **Ride Free Circuit Permit** for free rides on RTA fixed route bus and rail services provided by CTA, Pace, and Metra. All other seniors age 65 and older who are not qualified for the low-income Circuit Breaker Program are eligible to ride for half-fare with a **Reduced Fare Permit.** The new cards **must** be presented starting September 1. Until then, all seniors may continue to ride for "free".
