Fall at the Morton Arboretum

The Morton Arboretum in Lisle will be our trip destination in October. While you won't have time to explore all 1,700 acres of the Arboretum, we hope you'll see some beautiful fall colors and wildlife that calls the Arboretum home. The fall migrating season is a perfect time to catch a glimpse of some of the almost 50 species of birds that have been sighted there. If you're intrigued, join us on Tuesday, October 18. We'll leave the Center at 9:30 a.m. and travel via luxury coach bus to the Arboretum. Upon arrival, an Arboretum guide will step-on our bus and conduct a one-hour narrated tour through a portion of the grounds. You'll learn about their internationally-renowned plant collections, natural history, and research programs. After the tour, you can walk some of the paved and wood-chipped trails – maps are provided. Don't forget to dress for the weather if you intend to do some exploring. Lunch is on your own and available in the Ginkgo Restaurant or Café at the Arboretum. The restaurant offers a nice selection of gourmet sandwiches and salads and overlooks Meadow Lake. If you'd prefer, bring your own lunch and enjoy the "outdoor museum". We'll leave the Arboretum to return to the Center at approximately 1:30. The all inclusive cost for this trip is \$22. Payment is required to secure your reservation. We need a minimum of 20 sign-ups. We can accommodate no more than 30. Flu Shot Reminder

The Visiting Nurses Association of Fox Valley (VNA) will be administering flu shots at the Township on Monday, October 10th from 9-noon. Seniors signed up for Medicare Part B will have the cost of their flu shots covered by Medicare. Please bring your Medicare card. Geneva Township will pay the cost of the flu shot for any Geneva Township resident age 55+ not covered by Medicare Part B. For all others, the cost of the flu shot is \$20.00 and the cost of the pneumonia shot is \$53.00. For the 4th year the DPT (diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis) shot will also be offered. The cost of the DPT shot is \$45.00. A doctor's prescription will be required for any shot other than the flu shot. Any payment must be by cash or check only. Seniors who need transportation to and from the Center should contact Sheri by October 5th. As always, free refreshments will be served.
