FREE Flu Shot Clinic on Columbus Day

Geneva Township is once again sponsoring a free flu shot clinic. The clinic is scheduled for Monday, Oct. 12 (Columbus Day) from 9:00 to 12:00 noon. Nurses from the Visiting Nurses Association of Fox Valley (VNA) will administer the shots. Seniors signed up for Medicare Part B will have the cost of their flu shots covered by Medicare. Please bring your Medicare card. Geneva Township will pay the cost of the flu shot for any Geneva Township resident age 55+ not covered by Medicare Part B. For all others the cost of the flu shot is \$25.00. Any payment must be by cash or check only. Seniors who need transportation to the Center should contact Sheri by October 1st.
