If you need help paying your utility bills this winter and you meet certain income guidelines for **LIHEAP**, Betty Erickson will be at the Center on **Monday**, **September 12** to help you fill out an application for energy assistance. Eligible households must have a yearly total income at or below \$17,820 for a family of one and \$24,036 for two family members. FREE Flu Shot Clinic on Columbus Day

Geneva Township is once again sponsoring a free flu shot clinic. The clinic is scheduled for Monday, Oct. 10 (Columbus Day) from 9:00 to 12:00 noon. Nurses from the Visiting Nurses Association of Fox Valley (VNA) will administer the shots. Seniors signed up for Medicare Part B will have the cost of their flu shots covered by Medicare. Please bring your Medicare card. Geneva Township will pay the cost of the flu shot for any Geneva Township resident age 55+ not covered by Medicare Part B. For all others the cost of the flu shot is \$35.00. Any payment must be by cash or check only. Seniors who need transportation to the Center should contact Sheri by October 1st. As always, free refreshments will be served.
