Nurses from the Visiting Nurses Association of Fox Valley (VNA) will adminthe quadrivalent vaccine. Quadrivalent flu vaccines protect against four strains of influenza viruses. Seniors signed up for Medicare Part B will have the cost of their flu shots covered by Medicare. Please bring your Medicare card. Geneva Township will pay the cost of the flu shot for any Geneva Township resident age 55+ not covered by Medicare Part B. For all others the cost of the flu shot is \$35.00. Any payment must be by cash or check only. Seniors who need transportation to the Center should contact Sheri by October 5th. As always, free refreshments will be served.
