FREE Flu Shot Clinic

Geneva Township is once again sponsoring a free flu shot clinic. The clinic is scheduled for **Monday, Oct. 8** (Columbus Day) from 9:00 to 12:00 noon. Nurses from the Visiting Nurses Association of Fox Valley (VNA) will administer the shots. Seniors signed up for Medicare Part B will have the cost of their flu shots covered by Medicare. Please bring your Medicare card. Geneva Township will pay the cost of the flu shot for any Geneva Township resident age 55+ not covered by Medicare Part B. For all others, the cost of the flu shot is \$35.00. Payment must be in the form of cash or check only. As always, free refreshments will be served.

Medicare Information Series

In anticipation of the **Medicare Open Enrollment** period which is **October 15 – December 7**, the Center has again scheduled a series of four Medicare informational sessions in October and November. See the schedule below. Each session will focus on a different part of the program with ample time devoted to questions. Our presenter, Betty Erickson, makes this complicated program very clear.
