AgeGuide Needs Your Input!


On Monday, November 13 at 11:00am the non-profit AgeGuide invites Center members to participate in a one hour listening session at the Center as part of AgeGuide's evaluation that occurs every three years per the federal Older Americans Act. They coordinate a wide variety of services in northeastern Illinois and work closely with the Illinois Department on Aging. These sessions can provide valuable feedback about programs and services offered to persons aged 60 and over and will be used in developing a new Area Plan in the eight-county region that includes Kane County. Sessions are like focus groups with AgeGuide facilitators introducing the purpose of the open discussion and then leading a conversation with small groups (10-12 individuals) of participants about challenges and needs. Senior Services Associates and Kane Senior Council (home-delivered meals) among other local agencies are funded and monitored by AgeGuide. Don't miss this opportunity; you can make a difference! As a thank you to participants, AgeGuide is providing a lunch and raffling off four gift cards immediately after the listening sessions. Join the Book Club

On Wednesday, November 29th at 10:30 a.m. join the Center book club for a discussion about this month's selection, The Measure by Nikki Erlick. Everyone's welcome! One morning, adults around the world find on their doorstep (or outside their tent, or next to their shelter bed) a box labeled with their name. Inside is a piece of string whose length, it turns out, represents their life span. Short strings, long strings, medium strings — every person over 21 receives one, delivered in strange containers that materialize out of nowhere. As the weeks go by and data is gathered, scientists declare the strings to be accurate in forecasting how long their recipients will live. Some people choose to look at their strings; others throw the unopened boxes off bridges, preferring not to know how much time they have left. Copies of the book will be available on November 1 at the Geneva Library (Book Club area on the 1st floor). Books in this section are returned to the shelf after 15 days.

Drury Lane Theatre Outing

There are only 5 tickets left for the classic Rodgers + Hammerstein adaptation of Cinderella at Drury Lane on Wednesday, December 6.
