NEW Trip to Pullman National Historical Park

The Pullman community is a historic neighborhood on Chicago's far south side that was once at the center of industry and workers' rights in America. A planned community built by industrialist George Pullman on landfill from the great Chicago fire, Pullman produced luxury rail cars and housed the workers who built them. Pullman's history, architecture, and vibrant community remain as a National Park. On **Thursday, September 11** a group from the Center will travel by luxury coach bus to the Pullman Exhibit Hall for an orientation and overview before departing on an approximately 40-minute neighborhood walking tour conducted by the Historic Pullman Foundation. They'll explore the general history of Pullman (town and man), architecture, labor movement, railcars, and more. At the conclusion of the walking tour, we'll return to the Exhibit Hall for a catered lunch. The all-inclusive cost of this excursion is \$45. The Center Book Club choice this month is *Personal Librarian* by **Marie Benedict**. A work of historical fiction... In her twenties, Belle da Costa Greene is hired by J. P. Morgan to curate a collection of rare manuscripts, books, and artwork for his newly built Pierpont Morgan Library. Belle becomes a fixture in New York City society and one of the most powerful people in the art and book world, known for her impeccable taste and shrewd negotiating for critical works as she helps create a world-class collection. But Belle has a secret, one she must protect at all costs. She was born not Belle da Costa Greene but Belle Marion Greener. She is the daughter of Richard Greener, the first Black graduate of Harvard and a well-known advocate for equality. New readers are always welcome!
